Camper Frequently Asked Questions:

1.)When are meal times?

Breakfast is at 8:00am, lunch is at 12:00pm, and dinner is at 5:30pm. Please be prompt.

2.)How are the meals served?

Meals are served buffet style with a full salad bar. Once everyone is seated, someone from our staff will have announcements and prayer. Our staff will then individually dismiss each table to go to the buffet line.

3.)Are bed linens provided?

Linens are not provided. Please bring either a sleeping bag and pillow, or a fitted sheet and blanket.

4.)When we arrive, where do we check in?

Your leader will check in at the office to confirm your numbers, review camp rules and go over last minute questions. This will also be the time that the liability forms for each camper is due. The campers will check in with their leaders in their meeting room.

5.)What types of recreational activities are offered?

Gym – Full court basketball, volleyball, and table games (ping-pong, Frisbee, Corn hole and Foosball)

Archery – Available through reservation with office. Instructor will provide all gear at the archery range.

Sports Field – Grassy field with basketball, volleyball, Gaga ball and horseshoes adjacent.

Miniature Golf Course – 9 holes; check out clubs and balls at the office.

Board Games – Available for check out at the office by an adult.

6.)What types of sleeping accommodations are offered?

There are four dormitory style buildings (The Oak Units), the Pine units, Cedar lodge, and cottage accommodations. Sleeping accommodations will be determined based upon the size of your group.

7.)What type of meeting facilities do you have?

All meeting rooms are equipped with 8-foot tables, chairs, and an overhead screen. Most rooms have a piano and a dry erase white board. We appreciate your cooperation in not using your meeting rooms for crafts.

8.)What types of wildlife are on the grounds?

We have a large population of squirrels, rabbits, coyotes, raccoons, possums, and rodents. We also have occasional bears and bobcats.

9.)What are the policies regarding food in the meeting and sleeping accommodations?

Due to the large population of bears and other animals, we do not allow guests to eat plated meals in the meeting and sleeping accommodations. However, we do allow prep-packaged, individual serving sized snacks to be consumed in the meeting accommodations all trash should be appropriately placed in the bear-proof trashcans upon consumption.

10.) What time are quiet hours?

Quiet hours are from 11:00pm to 7:00am. Amplification must be turned off by 11:00pm. Campers should be either in their sleeping or meeting rooms, after 11:00pm.

11.) Do you have wifi? Will my phone get service?

We provide Wifi to the leaders of each group. We do not provide the wifi to the campers of each group. We have very limited cell phone coverage, however, we do have a Verizon tower on our site, so you are in luck if you have Verizon.

12.) Is smoking allowed?

Smoking is not allowed. For the safety and health of all guests and staff, smoking is not permitted on our grounds.
